With no further business to discuss we proceeded to reading our different submissions of the optional assignment, **Fear**.

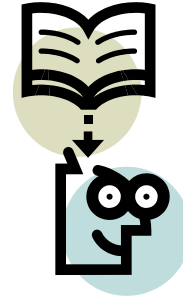
Reading:
