Reading:

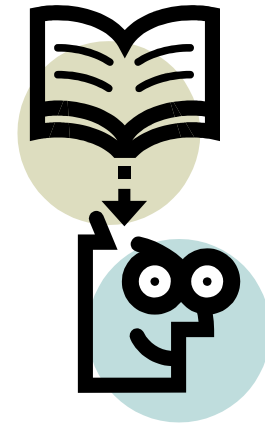
